#### Activating/deactivating

- 1 Switches on or off Active Distance Assist DISTRONIC
- ③ SET+ Activates Active Distance Assist SET- DISTRONIC with the current speed
- (4) GARES Activates with the stored speed/pulls away with Active Distance Assist DISTRONIC
  - **CNCL** Deactivates Active Distance Assist DISTRONIC



#### Changing the speed

- 2 Increases the specified distance Reduces the specified distance  $/ \sim$

### Active Distance Assist DISTRONIC

Active Distance Assist DISTRONIC maintains a constant speed which has been stored. The lowest speed that can be set is 12 mph (20 km/h).

You can change the set speed:

(2) Turn signal light, right

③ Headlamp flasher

(4) Turn signal light, left

- 1 mph step (1 km/h): Briefly press rocker switch ③ up or down.
- 5 mph step (10 km/h): Press rocker switch ③ up or down beyond the pressure point.

Using rocker switch (2), you can change the specified distance to the vehicle in front. The specified distance depends on the currently driven speed.

If rocker switch ④ is pressed upwards twice, Distance Assist DISTRONIC is activated with the speed restriction displayed in the instrument cluster.

Note that your vehicle may not be equipped with all of the features described.

Operating possibilities for climate control

- You can set automatic climate control using: • The rocker switches on control panel ① of the
- center console
- · The air conditioning menu of the multimedia system

Air-conditioning function bar 2 shows the most important settings and the status of the climate control system.

### Automatic climate control panel

- Sets the temperature

- AUTO Sets climate control to automatic mode

- MENU Calls up the air conditioning menu If you press and hold the MENU button for approximately 4 seconds, automatic climate control will be reset to the basic settings. Residual heat with the engine off
- tttREAR Defrosts the rear window
- SYNC Synchronized operation
- Air-recirculation mode <u></u>
- The air in the interior is recirculated; the windows may fog up more quickly.
- A/c Cooling with air dehumidification

- Ionization Freshens the air in the vehicle interior using ionization

#### Operating the on-board computer

**Voice Control System** 

#### Starting a dialog

The Voice Control System allows you to comfortably operate the majority of the multimedia system's functions.

- To say a voice command: Press the with button and say a voice command after the acoustic signal.
- If a mobile phone is connected to the multimedia system of the vehicle via button, the mobile phone's voice control feature is activated.

#### Voice Control System help functions

#### • General notes:

- Say the "Help Voice Control System" voice command.
- Help for the current function: Say the "Help" voice command.
- Help for a specific system: Say the voice command for the desired system, e.g. "Help telephone".

#### Examples

#### Voice commands for navigation

- "Navigate to Woodward Avenue, Detroit" Starts route guidance to the named address.
- "Navigate to contact John Doe Starts route guidance to a contact in the address book.
- "Nearest gas station" Further categories are also available: restaurant, parking lot and rest area.

# Voice commands for telephone

## "Call Jane Doe"

- Calls the number of a contact in the address book.
- "Latest calls"
- Shows the latest calls.

#### Voice commands for audio mode

- "Station Z100"
  - Calls up stations which are in range or stored stations
- "Play Moonlight Sonata" Plays the named media file. All tracks available in the system can be used.

## **Favorites**

Favorites allow you to quickly call up applications which you use regularly.

- **To call up the menu:** Press the 🟠 button. The main functions are displayed.
- Navigate downwards.
- The favorites bar is shown.
- To create your own favorite: Select the desired function in the multimedia system.
- Press and hold the 🟠 button until the favorites are displayed.
- Add your own favorite at the desired position. Personalization

### You can store your own personal settings for the multimedia system in a user profile.

- **To call up the menu:** Press the 🟠 button.
  - ► Select ¬→ System >> 4 Personalization.

**Quick-access to audio sources** 

Depending on the audio source to which you are currently listening, you can move to the next radio station or music track.

• To open the access bar: Swipe up with two fingers.

- Press the button on the touchpad.
- To select the previous or next station/ music track: Using a single finger, swipe up or down.
- To close the access bar: Swipe down with two fingers.

Note that your vehicle may not be equipped with all of the features described.



You can enter individual letters.

- **To delete** c: Swipe to the left.
- **To insert a space \_\_\_**: Swipe to the right.

#### **Quickly storing radio stations**

If you are listening to the radio and the Radio menu is shown in the multimedia system:

- Press and hold the controller/touchpad/righthand Touch Control of the multifunction steering wheel.
- An acoustic signal confirms the save.


