



### Cockpit - overview



- 1 Door handle

- (2) Seat functions

- ⑤ **&** Button for breakdown assistance call\* (mbrace System)



# Overview

- Combination switch for turn signals, 1 high-beam headlamps and windshield wipers
- Lever for electrical steering column adjustment
- Lever for cruise control/Active Distance 3 Assist DISTRONIC



Combination switch - windshield wiper **functions** 

- 1 Single wipe Wipes with washer fluid
- Windshield wipers off
- Intermittent wiping, normal Intermittent wiping, frequent
- Continuous wiping, slow Continuous wiping, fast




# Combination switch - lighting functions

- 1 High-beam headlamps or
- Adaptive Highbeam Assist Plus 2 Turn signal, right
- 3 High-beam flasher 4) Turn signal, left

## Changing the speed

- ① Switches on with the current speed or calls up the last set speed
- (2) Deactivates Active Distance Assist DISTRONIC
- ③ Increases the speed or stores the current
- 4 Decreases the speed or stores the current speed
- 5 Increases the specified minimum distance 6 Reduces the specified minimum distance
- constant speed which has been stored. The lowest speed that can be set is 20 mph (30 km/h).You can change the set speed: ▶ 1 mph (1 km/h) step: Briefly press the lever
- up or down.

**Active Distance Assist DISTRONIC** 

Active Distance Assist DISTRONIC maintains a

5 mph (10 km/h) step: Press the lever up or down past the pressure point.

When Active Distance Pilot DISTRONIC is activated, one or two segments in the set speed range light up in the speedometer. Using the controller on the DISTRONIC lever, you

can change the specified minimum distance to the vehicle in front. The specified minimum distance depends on the currently driven speed.

# Climate control

# Climate control control panel

- Defrosts the windshield ZONE Sets climate zones separately
- A/c Activates or deactivates the cooling function of climate control.
- Defrosts the rear window
- Reduces the airflow
- Increases the airflow
- **OFF** Completely activates or deactivates climate control.
- AUTO Sets climate control to automatic mode Air-recirculation mode
- The air in the vehicle interior is recirculated. In air-recirculation mode, the windows can fog up more quickly.
- REST Residual heat with the engine off

Sets the air distribution

### **General notes** Climate control regulates the temperature and

the humidity in the vehicle interior and filters undesirable substances out of the air. Climate control is only operational when the engine is running. Optimum operation is only achieved when the side windows and the roof are

closed. To prevent the windows from fogging up, please observe the following information:

- **OFF** Switches off climate control only briefly
- Switch on air-recirculation mode only
- A/c Switch on the cooling function. In warm weather, the air inside the vehicle will be cooled. This function also dries the air inside the vehicle.
- If necessary, briefly switch on the windshield defroster

## **Voice Control System**

### Starting a dialog

The Voice Control System allows you to comfortably operate the majority of the multimedia system's functions.

▶ To say a command: Press the 🗦 🔊 button and say a command after the audible signal.

### **Voice Control System help functions**

- General information:
- Say the "Help Voice Control System" command.
- · Help for the current function: Say the "Help" command.
- Help for a specific system: Say the help command for the desired system, e.g. "Help telephone".

If you press the  $3_{ij}$  button, the possible commands are shown in a help window. You can switch off the display of this help window in the multimedia system. **Examples**

### **Navigation commands**

- "Enter destination" A dialog for entering a destination in the navigation system will be started. Thereafter, say the destination address.
- "Nearest gas station" Many more categories for points of interest are available, e.g. restaurant or tourist attraction.
- "Navigate to John Doe" Start route guidance to a contact from your address book.

## Telephone commands


- "Call John Doe"
- The telephone number of a stored contact is dialed.
- "New message" A dialog for entering a text message (SMS) will be started.

## **Audio commands**

- "Station Z100"
- If you are listening to the radio, you can say the name of a station to which you would like to listen.
- "Search for music"
- A dialog in which you can search through your music files will be started.

## Overview of the multimedia system



You can operate the menus of the multimedia system using the controller.

- Controller: Turn or slide in the direction of the desired entry.
- Confirm your choice by pressing the controller.



 Back button Press and hold: Switches to the basic menu

★ Calls up or changes favorites

## Operating the multimedia system



Example image: COMAND

1 Adds a new favorite

② Renames a selected favorite 3 Moves a selected favorite

For rapid access to functions which are called up frequently, you can create up to 20 favorites.

### Adding a predefined favorite Press the \star button.

- The favorites are displayed.
  - Slide the controller down. The menu bar is shown.
- Select Reassign and use the controller to select a category.
- Select a favorite and store it in the desired position.

# Quickly storing radio stations

- If you are listening to the radio and the Radio menu is shown in the multimedia system: Press and hold the controller until the station
- list is shown. Select the desired preset in the station list and confirm.
- A tone confirms the save.

## Requirement

- Bluetooth<sup>®</sup> is switched on on the mobile phone (see the manufacturer's operator's manual).

## Searching for a mobile phone

- Press the TEL button on the center console. Select Conn. Device 1.
- Audio 20: Select Connect New Device.
- Select Connect via Vehicle. Select the desired mobile phone.
- If possible, select the intended usage of the mobile phone (main or secondary phone).
- **COMAND:** Select Search for Phones. Select Start Search.

Select the desired mobile phone.

If your mobile phone is not found, try searching on the mobile phone itself.
