



























Gearshift pattern for transmission


① Release button

- ► Make sure the gear selector lever is set to park position **P**. The transmission position indicator should be on P.
- ▶ Do not depress the accelerator pedal.
- ➤ Turn the key to starter switch position 2 and release it again immediately. The engine starts automatically ("touch-start" function).




