

Lever on the steering wheel



Overview

- 1 Combination switch for turn signals, highbeam headlamps and windshield wipers
- Lever for electrical steering wheel adjustment
- Lever for cruise control/Distance Pilot DISTRONIC



Combination switch - windshield wiper functions

- Single wipe
- Wipes the windshield using washer fluid • Windshield wipers off
- ••• Intermittent wiping, normal
- 3 Intermittent wiping, frequent Continuous wiping, slow 5 Continuous wiping, fast

2 Operates the rear window wiper



Combination switch - lighting functions

- 1 High-beam headlamps or Adaptive Highbeam Assist Plus
- Turn signal, right
- 3 High-beam flasher 4 Turn signal, left

Activating/deactivating Changing the speed

- Switches on with the current speed or calls up the last set speed
- 2 Deactivates Distance Pilot DISTRONIC

Distance Pilot DISTRONIC maintains a constant

Distance Pilot DISTRONIC

speed which has been stored. The lowest speed that can be set is 20 mph

(30 km/h).You can change the set speed:

1 mph (1 km/h) step: Briefly press the lever up or down.

▶ 5 mph (10 km/h) step: Press the lever up or

down past the pressure point. When Distance Pilot DISTRONIC is activated, one

or two segments in the set speed range light up in the speedometer. Using the controller on the DISTRONIC lever, you

can change the specified minimum distance to the vehicle in front. The specified minimum distance depends on the currently driven speed.

Adjusting automatic climate control

You can adjust automatic climate control using

the buttons on control panel 1). If you change any settings, the lower edge of display 2 briefly shows the current settings of automatic climate control.

Automatic climate control panel Defrosts the windshield

- **ZONE** Sets climate zones separately Activates or deactivates the cooling
- function of automatic climate control. Residual heat with the engine off (Canada
- only) Defrosts the rear window
- Reduces the airflow 88

Climate control

To prevent the windows from fogging up, please observe the following information: **OFF** Switch off automatic climate control only


- briefly Switch on air-recirculation mode only
- briefly A/c Switch on the cooling function.
- In warm weather, the air inside the vehicle will be cooled. This function also dries the air inside the vehicle. If necessary, briefly switch on the
- windshield defroster.





Operating the Voice Control System

- 10 Starts a dialog

Operating the menu of the on-board computer

- 1 Scrolls through lists Selects a submenu or function
- Calls up the menu and menu bar
- 3 OK Confirms the selected entry
- 4 Back button
- Telephone/media functions
- 6 Accepts a telephone call
- Rejects a telephone call Ends a call

Voice Control System

Starting a dialog

The Voice Control System allows you to comfortably operate the majority of the multimedia system's functions.

- ▶ To say a command: Press the 3, button and say a command after the audible signal.
- **Voice Control System help functions**
- **General information:** Say the "Help Voice Control System" command. Help for the current function:
- Say the "Help" command. • Help for a specific system: Say the help command for the desired system, e.g. "Help telephone".

If you press the 3, button, the possible commands are shown in a help window. You can switch off the display of this help window in the multimedia system. **Examples**

Navigation commands "Enter destination"

- A dialog for entering a destination in the navigation system will be started. Thereafter, say the destination address.
- "Nearest gas station" Many more categories for points of interest are available, e.g. restaurant or tourist attraction. "Navigate to John Doe"
- Start route guidance to a contact from your address book.

Telephone commands "Call John Doe"


- The telephone number of a stored contact is
- "New message" A dialog for entering a text message (SMS) will be started.

Audio commands

- "Station Z100"
- If you are listening to the radio, you can say the name of a station to which you would like to "Search for music"
- A dialog in which you can search through your music files will be started.



Rapid access to audio sources

Depending on the audio source to which you are currently listening, you can move to the next radio station or music track.

- To open the access bar: Swipe up with two
- ▶ Press the ►► button on the touchpad. To select the previous or next station/ music track: Swipe to the left or right.
- To close the access bar: Swipe down with two fingers.



Operating the multimedia system

Handwriting recognition

You can enter individual letters.

- ▶ **To delete** c: Swipe to the left.
- ▶ To insert a space ____: Swipe to the right. Quickly storing radio stations

If you are listening to the radio and the Radio menu is shown in the multimedia system:

- Press and hold the controller or touchpad until the station list is shown. Select the desired preset in the station list and
- confirm. A tone confirms the save.

Establishing a Bluetooth® connection

Searching for a mobile phone Press the TEL button on the center console.

- Select Conn. Device 1.
- Audio 20: Select Connect New Device.
- Select Connect via Vehicle.
- Select the desired mobile phone. If possible, select the intended usage of the
- mobile phone (main or secondary phone).
- **COMAND:** Select Search for Phones.

Select the desired mobile phone.

Select Start Search.

If your mobile phone is not found, try searching on the mobile phone itself.

Authorizing a mobile phone


