





Activating/deactivating Changing the speed

- Switches on with the current speed or calls up the last set speed

Distance Pilot DISTRONIC maintains a constant

Distance Pilot DISTRONIC

speed which has been stored. The lowest speed that can be set is 20 mph

(30 km/h).You can change the set speed:

1 mph (1 km/h) step: Briefly press the lever up or down.

▶ 5 mph (10 km/h) step: Press the lever up or down past the pressure point.

When Distance Pilot DISTRONIC is activated, one or two segments in the set speed range light up in the speedometer. Using the controller on the DISTRONIC lever, you

can change the specified minimum distance to the vehicle in front. The specified minimum distance depends on the currently driven speed.



Adjusting climate control You can adjust automatic climate control using

Automatic climate control panel Defrosts the windshield

- Sets climate zones separately (Canada only)
- Activates or deactivates the cooling function of automatic climate control.
- Defrosts the rear window
- Reduces the airflow
- Increases the airflow
- Completely activates or deactivates automatic climate control.
- Air-recirculation mode
- The air in the interior will be recirculated. In air-recirculation mode, the windows can fog up more quickly.
- Residual heat with the engine off (Canada
- Maximum cooling (USA only) MAX
- Sets the air distribution





The Voice Control System allows you to comfortably operate the majority of the multimedia system's functions.

▶ To say a command: Press the 3, button and say a command after the audible signal.

Voice Control System help functions

- **General information:** Say the "Help Voice Control System" command.
- Help for the current function: Say the "Help" command.
- Help for a specific system: Say the help command for the desired system, e.g. "Help telephone".

If you press the 3, button, the possible commands are shown in a help window. You can switch off the display of this help window in the multimedia system.

Examples

Navigation commands "Enter destination"

- A dialog for entering a destination in the navigation system will be started. Thereafter, say the destination address. "Nearest gas station"
- Many more categories for points of interest are available, e.g. restaurant or tourist attraction. "Navigate to John Doe"
- Start route guidance to a contact from your address book.

Telephone commands "Call John Doe"


- The telephone number of a stored contact is
- "New message" A dialog for entering a text message (SMS) will be started.

Audio commands

- "Station Z100" If you are listening to the radio, you can say the name of a station to which you would like to
- "Search for music"
- A dialog in which you can search through your music files will be started.

Adding a pre-defined favorite ▶ Press the ★ button.

- The favorites are displayed. Slide the controller down.
- The menu bar is shown.
- Select Reassign and use the controller to select a category.
- Select a favorite and store it in the desired position.

Adding your own favorite

You can create your own favorites, e.g. telephone numbers or navigation destinations. Example for a telephone number:

- Press the TEL button and select Name in the Telephone menu. Select a contact and display the telephone
- number. Press and hold the * button until the
- favorites are displayed. Add a favorite at the desired position.

- Press the TEL button on the center console. Select Conn. Device 1.
- Audio 20: Select Connect New Device. Select Connect via Vehicle.
- Select the desired mobile phone. If possible, select the intended usage of the
- mobile phone (main or secondary phone).
- **COMAND:** Select Search for Phones.
- Select Start Search. Select the desired mobile phone.
- If your mobile phone is not found, try searching on the mobile phone itself.

Establishing a Bluetooth® connection


