Link *Mercedes me* to your Google Home using the Google Home app.

1. Open the **Google Home app** on your phone (iOS or Android)
2. Tap the **Menu** in the top left
3. Go to **Explore**, and search for ***Mercedes me***
4. Select *Mercedes me*, and tap “**Link Account**”
5. Enter your *Mercedes me* credentials, and tap “**Log In**”

2. In the **Explore Menu**, under **Travel & Transportation**, search for ***Mercedes me***.

3. Tap “**Link**” on the *Mercedes me* page
4. Enter your *Mercedes me* credentials, and tap “**Log In**”
5. You’re all set! Enjoy *Mercedes me* on your Google Home

“Ok Google, let me talk to *Mercedes me*.”

For managing multiple vehicles, you can change your primary car by stating:

“Ok Google, ask *Mercedes me* to update my primary car.”
